# Minutes of the induction meeting held on 18.06.2018 (Monday)

The induction meeting begun by 9:40 am after the prayer - Tamizhthaai Vazhthu.

## Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 29.06.2018 (Friday)

At first, Dr. S. K. Sundar, IQAC Coordinator welcomed the members of the IQAC and briefed the agenda of the meeting. He insisted that the pending AQARs are to be submitted to the NAAC though the preparation is already half- way through. Subsequently, he invited the IQAC Chairperson & Principal Dr. T. Chitrakalarani, who presided over the meeting and her remarks are as under:

While she was hopeful that Continuous Internal Assessment is being done effectively (in terms of providing feedback after tests & model exams, students' assignments & seminar classes, group discussions etc.), she also underscored the importance of the activity towards enhanced learning of the students.

Principal also discussed how monthly meeting of class teachers/ mentors with their class students / mentees would be beneficial towards learners' academic performance and thus the activity was insisted.

In this regard, Prof. S. Ravi, Associate Professor & Head, Department of Chemistry remarked that an exclusive staff committee should be in place as to counsel students who are habituated to ill-behaviors/ habits. Principal responded that it would be done suitably. Citing a oral communication from the Directorate of Collegiate Education, Chennai, Principal also conveyed that mobile phone usage by students is prohibited in the campus and all staff as well as staff members in 'students disciplinary committee' should be vigilant of the same.

### Principal emphasized the following:

- 1. To continue the on-going remedial classes for the benefit of under-performing students.
- To receive feedback from the students as to fine-tune the teaching methodology that will favor them the most.
- To make use of the internet facilities available at the 'digital library' by the research scholars and staff members.
- To encourage students and research scholars including staff members to avail books as many times as possible from the library.
- Principal emphasized that the Part IV courses (Value Education, Soft Skill Development etc.) will have to be used as an effective mean of counseling the students with respect to self- introspection, values of human life, its purpose, personality development etc.,

- 6. Similarly, Principal said that the in-charge of the Computer Literacy Program (CLP) should ensure that the content of the program is delivered letter and spirit among the students; they are trained so that they are independent of computer usage with respect to the common domains like MS- Word and MS- Excel as these two would provide them good job/ earning opportunities.
- 7. IQAC chairperson further insisted on submission of research proposals for grant, article publications, participation in workshops and seminars; faculty development programs etc. While Dr. N. Dhanarajan, Associate Professor & Head, Department of Tamil suggested that the teachers shall guide the outgoing under graduate and post graduate students in preparing their bio-data or resume that would help them when they apply for some placements, everybody acceded including the Principal who strongly recommended the suggestion. She also added that the M.Phil. and Ph.D scholars of each department shall be allowed to assist the students in this regard.

As Dr. S.K. Sundar, Assistant Professor of Microbiology / IQAC Coordinator reminded the Principal of pending AQAR submission, Principal spoke about it strongly; informed the Head of the Departments and the Bursar, from College office, to work towards the same in war-footing mode.

# Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 6th August 2018 (Monday)

Welcome address: Dr. S.K. Sundar, Assistant Professor of Microbiology & IQAC Coordinator

Remarks & presidential address: Dr. T. Chitrakalarani, Principal & IQAC Chairperson. In her address to the members, she said that the institution is student centric; planning and working out its academic activities to benefit the regional students so as to brighten them with academic grit, ability; and as able graduates. She pleasantly welcomed Dr. R. Saravanamuthu, Retired Professor of Botany, Department of Botany, AVC College (Autonomous), Mayiladuthurai – 609 305, Nagapattinam District, Tamil Nadu & Dr. A. Paneer Selvam, Head, Department of Botany & Microbiology, AVVM Sri Pushpam College, Thanjavur, the two external experts of the IQAC and requested for their remarks.

Dr. R. Saravanamuthu with a warm greeting to all the IQAC members insisted about the students' feedback system for a better curricular planning as well as for its effective implementation. He asked that the outcomes of the student feedback must be taken to the knowledge of authorities appropriately as to reflect the expectations of the students in the curriculum. The practice of collecting feedback from students with respect to their syllabi, its assessment, providing any specific feedback of students to the knowledge of the Chairperson or any one of the members of the Board of Studies (BOS) of the specific program, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli were subsequently informed to the external experts by Prof. S. Maran, Associate Professor & Head, Department of English. While Dr. R. Saravanamuthu was hopeful of the following, he also insisted the same:

- Remedial classes for needy students
- Mentors mentee meetings
- Students' participation in extra & co- curricular activities both within and outside the college campus
- Career counseling of students and assisting interested students in preparing for competitive examinations like TNPSC, Banking services etc.,
- Active participation of students & research scholars in science events, seminar, conferences, workshops etc.,

Similarly, Dr. A. Paneer Selvam inquired the status of MoUs inked by various departments with outside institutions. He underscored that at least one MoU should be signed by each department with anyone outside college, research centre, affiliating or other universities as this would enable students & research scholars visit and use facilities at the partnering institution as well as staff exchange for meaningful interactions & sharing of expertise. Prof. S. Sivaselvan, Assistant Professor & Head, Department of Physics informed that the Department of Physics has signed a MoU with Bon Secours College for Women, Thanjavur and the same has been in force since 22.06.2016.

In view of the fact that Ph.D. research scholars have involved in active research in many research departments, Dr. A. Paneer Selvam suggested that there is a scholarship 'Research Funding for Research Scholars (RFRS) provided by the Tamil Nadu State Council for Science and Technology (TNSCST) for full- time research scholars, the research guides & supervisors shall support such research scholars to draft and submit a proposal to the TNSCST as to enable them to obtain the scholarship, if their work proposal is approved for grant. Dr. K. Panneer Selvam, Assistant Professor & Head, Department of Microbiology was happy by informing that the proposal of his research scholar Mr. G. Nambirajan was approved and sanctioned by the TNSCST for the scholarship under the RFRS scheme. He also informed that Mr. G. Nambirajan has received his I year installment Rs. 1,50,000/- during March 2018 and would receive the II year installment this academic year. The subject expert appreciated the act and stated further that such scholarship schemes should be taken to the knowledge of all research scholars and PG students; any grant if received by the scholars / students would facilitate their research work or project work to a remarkable extent as well as help in improving facilities of their laboratories.

Dr. T. Chitrakalarani, Principal & IQAC Chairperson informed the external cum all internal members that Dr. K. Panneer Selvam, Assistant Professor & Head, Department of Microbiology has also been implementing a major research project sponsored by the Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science & Technology, Government of India; sanctioned during March 2018 and has just commenced the project as the Principal Investigator. Subsequently, the external subject experts responded that suitable schemes should be known by the staff members and research proposal should be submitted for grant.

Dr. K. Panneer Selvam, Assistant Professor & Head, Department of Microbiology also informed the members that the Department of Microbiology would organize a workshop at national level on the usage of the new origami microscope – foldscope with in the academic year as a part of the DBT major research project. He further stated that as another activity of the DBT project, the Department of Microbiology would sign a twining- program with St. Edmund's College,

Laitumkhrah, Shillong, Meghalaya which would basically be a MoU as to exchange staff expertise between the institutions.

While the both subject experts underscored the need for publishing research papers in indexed journals by staff members, they also insisted that the research scholars must be practiced to follow it as a sincere part of their research activity. It was also discussed about the in- campus and out- campus placements of students, students counseling, alumni association registration and activities through the Parents- Teachers Association (PTA), receiving general feedback from students with respect to their theory & practical sessions, teaching and coaching performance of staff members, adequacy of classes, career counseling, sports and other activities. Conclusively, Head of the Departments expressed their views unanimously that there has been a noticeable improvement in the academic activities of the college every year and were also much hopeful that the discussed points could be practiced to enhance various academic activities of the college. Principal / IQAC Chairperson thanked all the members of the IQAC as she also welcomed them for lunch.
