Organizing induction meetings to the newly admitted students of the academic year 2019 -2020.	IQAC organized induction meetings to the newly enrolled UG & PG students of all programs as to set their goals and thus their higher education period's academic cum career activities.
Career guidance program	Career Guidance Cell of the college organized a program on TNPSC (Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission) competitive exams and preparation strategies. Similar sessions were organized by the Departments of Tamil and Physics.
Submission of proposals by staff and research scholars to funding institutions for research grant.	PG microbiology students submitted research proposals to Tamil Nadu State Council for Science and Technology (TNSCST), Chennai for grant under the students' project scheme.
Resource mobilization - Research projects by the members of staff	Dr. K. Panneer Selvam, Assistnat Professor & head, Department of Microbiology received second instalment Rs. 1,32,324/-from the Department of Biotechnology (DBT), Ministry of Science and Technology, Government of India under the foldscope – major research project. Similarly, 4 post graduate student received each Rs. 7500/- from Tamil Nad State Council for Science & Technology (TNSCST), Chennai – 600 025 through th students project scheme under the guidance of Dr. V.
