AWARDS AND PRIZES OF IABMS 2023

IABMS has instituted various prizes under different categories. Those who would like to apply for the following awards must be an annual or life member of the association. All the papers must be accompanied by a duly filled-in declaration form (Format is enclosed). The manuscripts for the prize papers should be in Microsoft format (Times new roman, font size 12) and submitted (soft and hard copies) to "The General Secretary IABMS, Y Block No 57, 8th Street, Anna Nagar, Chennai - 600040 on or before 15th November 2023.

LIST OF AWARDS AND PRIZES - INSTITUTED BY IABMS*

1. M. K. NAMBIAR MEMORIAL ORATION AWARD- for an eminent scientist. This award is to be given to an outstanding scientist in Medical and Allied fields in a year and to a scientist of another faculty in the succeeding year. The executive committee will select the awardee each year.

2. Dr. E. BALAKRISHNAN MEMORIAL AWARD - the best research paper in ophthalmology for scientists below the age of 45 Years.

3. Mrs. THANGAM VASUDEVAN AWARD - for the best research paper in any aspect of Biomedical Sciences, for Scientists below the age of 45 years.

4. INDRA VASUDEVAN AWARD - for the best research paper on Prevention/Cure or any other aspect of Cancer. If no paper is available on cancer, it is left to the discretion of the committee to give the award to any other good research paper. Upper age limit is 45 years.

5. SIRI RESEARCH AWARD - for the best paper on any aspect of stress. Upper age limit for this prize is 45 years.

6. Dr. YELLAPRAGADA SUBBAROW MEMORIAL AWARD - for the best paper published in 'Biomedicine' during the previous one year. The selection will be made by the nominee of the donor. Hence, no separate entry for this prize need to be submitted.

7. THE PGIBMS AWARD - for the best oral-presentation of an original paper in any field of Biomedicine in the PGIBMS award session by a full time PG Student/Research scholar. The paper must be accompanied by a certificate from the Head of the Department to establish the bonafideness of the contestant. Papers submitted by regular teaching faculty of a department and those above the age of 35 years are not eligible for this award. No paper will be accepted for PGIBMS award session if submitted at the venue of the conference.

8. PROF. N. PADMANABHAN MEMORIAL AWARD for the best paper in physiology comprising the work carried out in any departments of physiology by a postgraduate student of physiology.

9. Dr. P. S. LALITHA AWARD - for the best research paper by a professional undergraduate, who may be an undergraduate of veterinary or any other professional course excluding medicine. The research paper must contain the student's original work and the student should be the first author. Review articles will not be considered for this award. In any year, if there are many eligible candidates, two of them will be selected for the award by a selection panel, appointed by the Executive Committee of IABMS.

10. Dr. LEELA KRISHNAMURTI MEMORIAL AWARD - for the best paper by any medical undergraduate. Papers submitted will be evaluated by a peer group for short-listing a minimum of three contestants for presentation at the annual conference. The selected three candidates will be adjudged at the annual conference by a panel of judges appointed among the experts attending the conference and two prizes will be awarded.

11. Dr. BRAMMAIAH SASTRI MEMORIAL AWARD - for Biomedical Scientists of eminence with proven academic and research contribution with not less than 25 years of professional standing. Eligible persons are to be nominated by a life member of IABMS/Peer Academicians. Self- Nominations will not be entertained. The nominations are to be made on

a plain paper with full address and designation of the proposer and the nominee. The proposal should have the consent letter of the nominee and his/her full biodata and overall contribution made by him/her. The nominations will be scrutinized by the Executive Committee / Subcommittee and the final decision will be taken by the Executive Committee. The selected scientist for this award will receive a Medal and a Scroll. If no nomination is received in a particular year, the Executive Committee can itself spell out a suitable person for the award.

12. AGATHIYAR AWARD - The award will be given to the best research paper in any branch of indigenous medicine such as Ayurveda, Unani and Siddha except homeopathy.

13. Dr. C. R. KRISHNAMURTHY MEMORIAL AWARD- This award is for a biomedical scientist of eminence in the field of Environmental Toxicology / Environmental Biology with proven academic and research contribution and with not less than 25 years of professional standing. Eligible persons are to be nominated by a life member of IABMS/Peer academicians. Nomination should be accompanied by consent letter and the bio- data of the nominee.

14. Mr. V. V. SWAMINATHAN DIAMOND JUBILEE RESEARCH ENDOWMENT AWARD - This award will be given to an eminent scientist who has done an outstanding contribution in the scientific evaluation of medical properties of plants. The eligibility for the award will be a minimum period of 20 years of research-cum-teaching experience in the evaluation of medicinal plants for their therapeutic use. Eligible persons are to be nominated by two life members of IABMS/ academicians. Nomination should be accompanied by a consent letter and bio-data of the nominee.

15. Dr. A. NAMASIVAYAM AWARD - This award is exclusively meant for mid-level scientist (above 40 years) for their original work done in the respective speciality in Indian basic medical sciences. An expert committee formed by the donor department namely "Department of Physiology, PGIBMS will evaluate the received papers and the decision of the committee is final.

16. Dr. M. S. KRISHNAMOORTHY AWARD - The award will be given to a scientist (no limit in age) who has contributed original research output to develop a new research methodology in the discipline of Pharmacology and Environmental toxicology. An expert committee consisting of Pharmacologists and Toxicologists nominated by executive committee will select the awardee.

17. PROF. SUNDARAM SUBRAMANIAM ORATION AWARD- The award is exclusively meant for an eminent scientist above 50 years of age in any branch of medical sciences who is a life member of IABMS. A peer committee constituted by the executive committee of IABMS in consultation with the donor will select the awardee.

ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

The national conference envisages a common platform for students, research scholars, academicians and industry professionals not only to share and discuss the recent advances in the field of biomedical and health science but also to bring out a direction to initiate partnerships in order to spearhead cutting edge research in biomedical sciences aimed at significant breakthroughs in the field of diagnostics and therapeutics. In addition, the forum will certainly pave a way to draft new proposals towards development of biomedical research. The highlight of the conference would be the plenary lectures by the experts, oral presentations by seasoned scientists, oral presentations by budding scientists, poster sessions, and award sessions.

As witnessed during COVID-19 medical emergencies, rapidly developed therapeutic approaches are the current needs; thus, comes translational science. It focuses on streamlining the process of translating *in-vitro* findings into reliable therapies. An unprecedented global health crisis due to Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome-Coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2) caused COVID-19 pandemic was declared in March 2020. Earliest phases of COVID-19 brought that SARS-CoV-2 infection could manifest in many ways, ranging from a completely asymptomatic condition to a serious illness with fatal complications requiring intensive care. Moreover, the evidence of pulmonary abnormalities, functional limitations, and long-term cardiovascular complications soon manifested in a substantial proportion of COVID-19 survivors, suggesting the existence of a post-acute COVID-19 syndrome causing residual disability and thus increased rehabilitation needs. Importantly, this gave rise to a vaccine race which, thanks to a global effort by the scientific community and governments, made possible the development of national prevention strategies based on mass vaccination protocols. To date, an estimated 13 billion vaccines have been administered worldwide. However, in the meantime, a plethora of new variants with different transmissibility rates and virulence appeared. Overall, the emergence of less virulent variants and the high immunisation coverage have altered the face of the pandemic, generating a significant easing of national restrictions in many countries while considerably reducing the perception of emergency. Nonetheless, mounting scientific evidence suggests that great caution is still required, as the vaccine fails to offer complete and persistent immunisation, with severe COVID-19 outcomes still possible despite full primary vaccination. Moreover, regardless of vaccination status, hospitalisation, and consequent sequelae clearly increase with the number of reinfections. Conclusively, it is that the pandemic could possibly lead to an evolution towards a new endemic phase. In this context, the requirement for high-quality preclinical and translational studies on COVID-19

remains unchanged, aiming to expound the mechanisms of infection and reinfection by the new variants, as well as the pathogenesis of acute manifestations and long-term complications.

Similarly, only a limited fraction of the complex and multiple molecular aspects of COVID-19 have been elucidated despite the vast number of articles published since the beginning of the pandemic. Interestingly, this number far exceeds that of papers dedicated to other respiratory diseases, including chronic obstructive pulmonary diseases, which have been studied for decades. Although only 3 years have passed, the growing scientific evidence on this new clinical condition is expected to increase further, as this reflects the enormous health, social, economic, and political impacts caused by the pandemic worldwide. It is that considerable uncertainty still emerges regarding the molecular mechanisms of SARS-CoV-2 infection and its consequences in various organs and tissues. Moreover, considering the virus ability to mutate into new strains, this knowledge about current variants and those that could newly emerge over time, further translational research is needed to better identification of the inflammatory pathways during infection with different variants and in vaccinated subjects as to enable new therapeutic strategies. It is also evident that our system of traditional medicine also meaningful in reducing the burden of viral infections like Covid-19. Having known the above facts, the following themes were designed and subjected for the exploration of translational research in Covid-19.

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

The contents of abstract should include background, objectives, methods, results and conclusions under these headlines. The title should be in capital and in bold followed by name of authors (with first name first, then middle name followed by family name) and their institutional address along with the email address of the corresponding author. Do not append degrees, professional designations, etc to names. The name of presenting author should be underlined. The abstract should be typed using Microsoft Word (Times New Roman, font size 12 and 1.5 point spacing between lines, limit 300 words). Abbreviations used in the body of an abstract should be defined at their first mention in the text and 4-5 keywords should be included. Abstracts can be submitted through email mrgaciabms2024@gmail.com.

Abstract will be considered for the publication only if the presenting author has registered for the conference. Normally only one paper is allowed per author, unless prior permission of organizers is taken. If an abstract is accepted and presenter does not register, the abstract will be withdrawn. The last date for submission of abstract is 15th December 2023. Accepted abstracts will be published in the book of abstracts.
