Prof. S. Ravi, Principal i/c and IQAC Chairperson presided over the meeting which began at 10:15 am and welcomed the two outside experts as well as all the members from the college. Principal thanked the outside experts for their good support in the form of various academic inputs and suggestions and informed the following during the first few minutes of the meeting:

- The college submitted a proposal seeking permission to admit additional seats in arts and humanities (Tamil, English, History, Commerce and BBA; 10 seats each) programs to the affiliating Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli.
- Institution has also submitted a proposal to the Directorate of Collegiate Education, Chennai to sanction new programs (BA, Journalism, B.A. Economics, BBA II Shift, BA History II shift, B.Sc., Zoology and M.Sc., Microbiology) as to offer the programs from 2017- 2018 academic year onwards.
- A full- time teaching staff (Dr. V. Saminathan, Assistant Professor of History) has been designated as the Physical Director in-charge of the college.
- Principal was glad to inform the members that the Government of Tamil Nadu has sanctioned a new building (with 15 class rooms and 5 laboratories) to the college as a part of its Dr. MGR birth centenary celebrations [Dr. M. G. Ramachandran (Dr. MGR) was the former honorable Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu].

Dr. R. Saravanamuthu, IQAC external member/ Professor from the Department of Botany, AVC College (Autonomous), Mayiladuthurai – 609 305, Nagapattinam District, Tamil Nadu expressed his happiness about the proposal submitted by the college for new programs. At the same time, he cautioned that in the event of obtaining any new programs sanctioned by the government to offer from the academic year, full- time teachers should be appointed in-parallel as to shoulder the additional work load in the form of teaching and coaching.

Principal informed that full- time teachers would either be appointed by the government immediately or the college itself can appoint temporarily until teachers are provided by the government.

To an inquisitiveness by Dr. A. Paneer Selvam, External member/ Head, Department of Botany & Microbiology, AVVM Sri Pushpam College, Thanjavur about the availability of student class rooms as to manage the possible additional need for classes, principal clarified that class room facilitates with aluminum roofing sheets could be erected to manage any such requirements.

Both the outside experts suggested that the strength and well-beingness of non-teaching staff are to be equally cared by the institution as its understood that a few non-teaching staff are serving in temporary positions with their payments done through institutional level accounts or heads like funds from Parents- Teachers Association or Old Students Association.

Further, it was also informed by the experts that additional grants shall be sanctioned from the college funds to each department either for laboratory or for books purchase.

The experts also expressed their hope that each department was connected with internet connectivity so as to effect research and teaching activities by staff members.

In addition, the external experts reviewed and underscored the following:

- Administrative and academic auditing by external authorities
- Sports and games events & their increased activities among students by the physical education department
- Students performance enhancement in the form of remedial and special classes
- Role of students disciplinary committee and anti-ragging committee as to ensure a good academic ambience in the campus
- Submission of mini or major research project proposals to state and central government funding agencies as a mean of promoting research activities as well as upgrading laboratory facilities through such funded research projects
- Publication of research articles in peer reviewed / indexed journals by staff and research scholars.
- Submission of proposals for fellowships by research scholars; Participation in workshops, seminars and conferences by students, research scholars and staff.
- Organizing state/ national level seminars/ conferences and workshops funded by external granting institutions to benefit staff members, research scholars as well as students of all programs.
- Role of NCC, NSS, YRC, RRC etc. in extension activities through the students as well as in knowledge enhancement.
- Educational tours, field and industrial visits for students and research scholars.
- Department Students Association meetings.
- Students soft skills development skills through class quizzes, students seminars, mock group discussions.
- Enhancement of digitalization activities suitably.
- Utilizing RUSA Phase II funds, if sanctioned to improve or increase physical infrastructure facilities, library purchase, sports facility, computer lab infra- structure, research facilities, etc. for quality enhancement
- Maintenance the college campus and a student's centric academic environment
- Appointing teaching and non-teaching staff to deliver the academic responsibilities more effectively.
- Preparation & submission of AQAR 2015- 2016 & 2016- 2017 to the NAAC.
