Welcome Address: Dr. S. Rajan, Assistant Professor of Microbiology & Associate NCC

Inaugural cum special address: Dr. D. Rajendran - Prinicpal/ IQAC Chairperson

Dr. D. Rajendran - Prinicpal/ IQAC Chairperson greeted all and conveyed the International Yoga Day - 2023 wishes to all. Also, he honoured the special guests cum yoga teachers with a shawl.

Dr. D. Rajendran - Prinicpal/ IQAC Chairperson stated that International Yoga Day is being celebrated across the globe; Honorable Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has visited USA today as a part of scheduled events between Indian and USA governments'; he is also scheduled to celebrate the International Yoga Day - 2023 with the people of the country. Principal said that yoga practices have become very popular and are highly recognized; being practised by people across the globe.

He said that ỹoga unites body, mind and intellect together; this leads to social well beingness/ social health of the individual who practices yoga. He shared his personal experience that he has been daily practising yoga for more than 30 years; doing yoga practices for about 45 minutes to 1 hour early in the morning and benefitting a lot with respect to the overall health. In view of the fact that mind wavers a lot & troubles everyone, yoga is an effective intervention or a medicine.

Other points of deliberation/interaction by Dr. D. Rajendran - Prinicpal/IQAC Chairperson:

Yoga can clean body, mind and can lead to a better social health. Yoga cleans mind in addition to physical body of a person.

Yoga can be done anywhere; will assist in propagating good habits, mental strength, not to get tempted towards junk- food etc.

Yoga is not only for any religion, language, caste, communicty, gender etc., and its above all and for all.


Yoga to be done at least for 30 minutes daily

Principal observed that he has personally been benefitted by practising yoga with respect to his gross health and expressed his better comfort of physical, mental and intellectual levels.

PRINCIPAL Subsequently, Mr. R. Rajendran, Yoga Trainer, Isa Van Gundation, Mannargudi instructed the following: Yoga is simple & ease and all can practice suitably. Yoga shall be done in empty stomach or after 1 hour to 1:30 minutes after a meal. Yoga not advisable to pregnant women. Yoga shall be done after appropriate advice by a physician/ doctor, if any one is in treatment for any ailments. After a minimum of 7 years from birth, yoga shall be practiced. In addition, Mr. R. Rajendran, Yoga Trainer explained the basic stages involved in yoga starting from stage I through stage VI. All the participants of the event followed and performed the practices/ steps [starting from standing- up, to opening the eyes, concentrating on a point, keeping palm at the centre of the chest, inhaling/ exhaling, arms up & down positions, 35 degree squat position, again inhaling and exhaling; arms up & down, holding arms straight and back while keeping the head position straight etc.] of each stage twice; first while instructing stages of yoga and second on their own. Dr. S. Rajkumar, Assistant Professor of Commerce and NSS unit in-charge delivered the vote of thanks and the meeting concluded with the National anthem. Dr. D. Introduction of the guest Dr. Somavalliappan: Dr. K. Gokulakrishnan, Assistant Professor of Chemistry/ Soft skill development coordinator.

Dr. Somavalliappan, in his inagural session expressed his happiness of being present in the campus infront of a huge young and energetic student minds of the college; he commenced his talk stating the importance of strength and courage for every human being. He said that if 'one' is ready to learn, teacher would come from anywhere/ everywhere. His subsequent delivery of information included the following:

He informed that a student Mr. Fedrick known to him spoke in English with a lot of grammatical mistake as he didn't know the English language well; however, he spoke confidently and later developed his language hugely.

By citing a story he explained how one thinks that he/ she is not talented though no one thinks that one is not talented. No one neither thinks nor doubts abouts anybody's talent / fedility. [two mischieves children were taken to a saint by their mother; one child ran back home without mother's knowledge while the other was presented before the saint. The saintly man inquired the child as to inform the 'whereabouts' of God; listening this, the second child also helter-skelter came back home; when asked for the the reason, he said that the saint inquired 'where the God is???' doubting that I have stolen the God, so, I ran and came back - is the story cited; here, saint didn't doubt the child but he thinks that way and responds accordingly]

Mr. Somavalliappan highlighted that 'Life battles don't go to a strong or a faster man; it goes to other people; the man who wins thinks that he can'; so, give-up that I cann't or I am not able to etc.,

Every journey needs a plan and hence a plan/ clarity is always required

When there's a target/ goal, one can achieve; Mr. Somavalliappan cited Mr. Arnold as an example, the popular actor of the film 'Terminator'; informed that within 4 years Mr. Arnold became a best body builder, most celebrated actor, then the Governer of California, USA.

He also insisted that one learns until one understand when to be understood; all successful people didn't win at first; don't be fearful to be defeated; He informed that the one popularly known as 'Tamil Thatha' actually failed in English but he became 'Tamil Thatha' out of his

He said that one should go to stage and speak fearlessly; should not worry that one is not able to perform.

He said about 'Talkers' forum' where everyone can talk on Wednesday; he shared an incident where a naughty fellow- classmate suddently named another one of the class, the named person had to go and talk though he was not good in English but, the incidnet changed his life and became a popular speaker. Mr. Somavalliappan underscored that everyone should cross the bridge of fear; he said that 'fail early'; 'fail often' and don't worry. One can improve.

The speaker also spoke about the importance of observation; By observing Mr. Sachin Tendulkar, cricketer's games, Mr. Sachin Siva became the captain of cricket for physicially challenged team; Mr. X who became a popular radio anchor by observation; Mr. Somavalliappan also said that 'Everything can be learnt out of observation'.

Commitment to be taken as an example; if you are to be successful, be committed.

He insisted that we should say 'No' to mistakes in the very first time itself; if not, and commit the mistake, then, it could become a habbit; would impact life negatively.

Mr. Somavalliappan responded with examples for a few quiries raised by the students participants.

At the end of the session, Dr. S. Ramu, Head, Department of Zoology proposed vote of thanks and the event concluded with the 'national anthem'.

Prayer: Tamilthai vazhthu

Welcome Address: Dr. Jenni, Assistant Professor of Zoology & NSS unit coordintor / incharage welcomed the gathering.

Presidential address: Dr. D. Rajendran - Prinicpal/ IQAC Chairperson

Dr. D. Rajendran - Prinicpal/ IQAC Chairperson greeted and conveyed his Teachers' Day - 2023 wishes to all. Also, he honoured the special guest with a shawl.

Dr. Bharathiselvam MD, Cardiologist, Bharathi Cardiac Hospital, Mannargudi was the special guest who delivered the Teachers' Day - 2023 special address among the teachers of the college.

He highlighted the following:

Dr. Bharathiselvan MD explained the basics of heart attack and inducted the gathering that 'no' exercise, stress, and food habits etc., could pre-dispose heart attack.

He said that as much as 90% heart attack patients are chronic smokers and 10% have had a history of higher stress.

Blood pressure is to be checked every year after crossing 40 years of age. Cholestrol to be in control and LDL as a signficant cause of heart attack. Salt, carbohydrate and oil/cholestrol should be taken at optimum levels and some times can even be 'nil'; it was informed that different types of oils are to be cycled in our usage for preparing food.

Dr. Bharathiselvam MD underscored the importance of a balanced diet; he also shared that millets based or non- polished food is more health friendly and to be consumed once or twice every week.

He listed out vegetables for consumption; fish for its omega fatty- acids; importance of fruits for a healthy living.

Dr. Bharathiselvan MD informed the gathering to avoid more salty fatty acid based foods, packed foods, as well as fast foods.

The guest speacker referred a 'Thirukkural' by Thiruvalluvar - 'Noinaati Noimudhal Naati Adhudhanikkum Vaainaati Vaaippach Cheyal' which states that 'Diagnose the illness, trace its cause, Seek the proper remedy and apply it with skill'.

Dr. D. Rajendran - Prinicpal/ IQAC Chairperson inquired the members whether the SSR could be submitted to the NAAC by June 2024 and a decision to be taken in this regard.

After inputs from all the members of the IQAC, NAAC Department coordinators as well as HODs, it was finalized to submit the IIQA and SSR after May 2024 to the NAAC.

Dr. M. Adhi Viswanathan, Managing Director, Pinnacle Biosciences, Kanyakumari insisted the following during his discussion with the members:

Importance of industrial visits by students and permitting students to undertake their project works in outside research institutes, laboratories, etc as to ensure a broader cum real-time exposure of them during their study period itself.

Students Skill development should be focused; Self employment through start- up schemes shall have to be encouraged; students should be inducted with the availability of incubation centres, bank loans etc., as to get in to self entreprenuership/ employment.
